

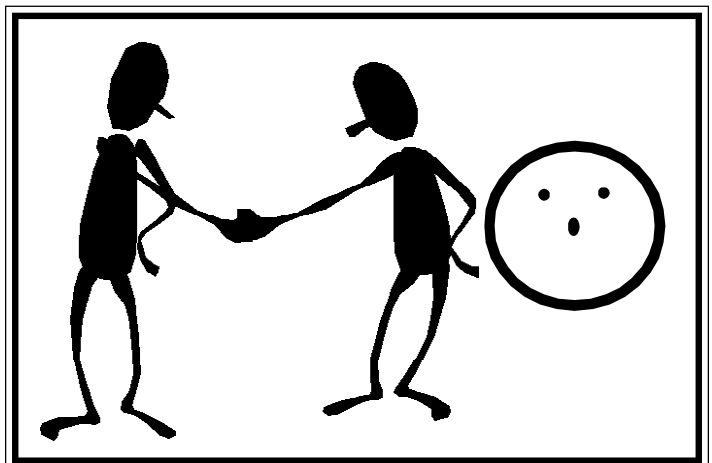
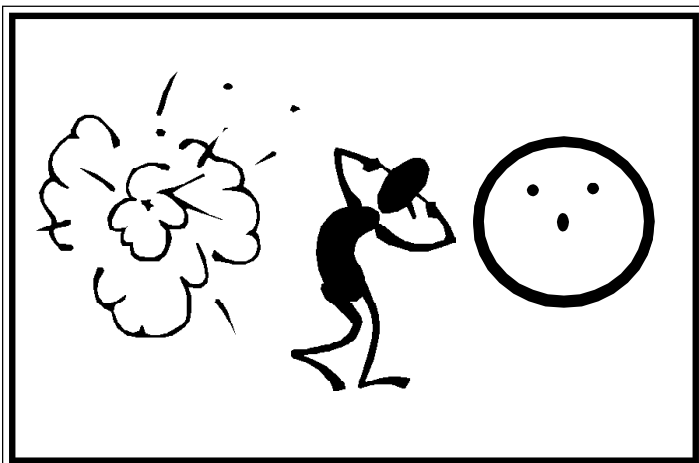
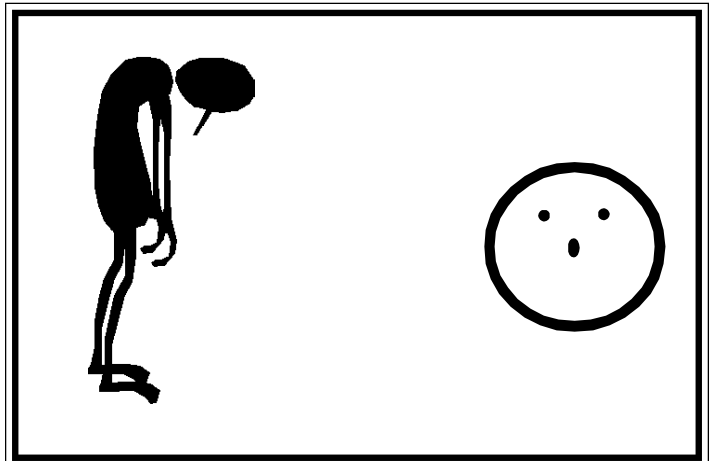
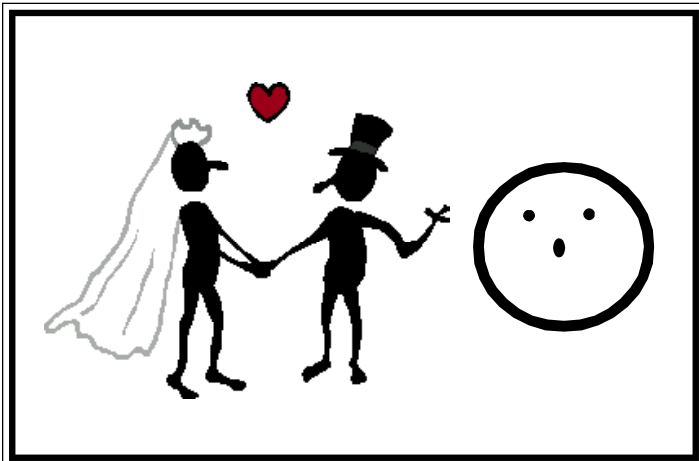
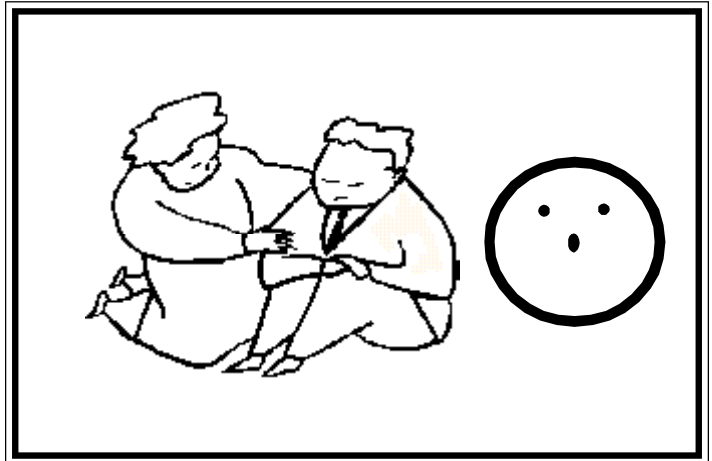
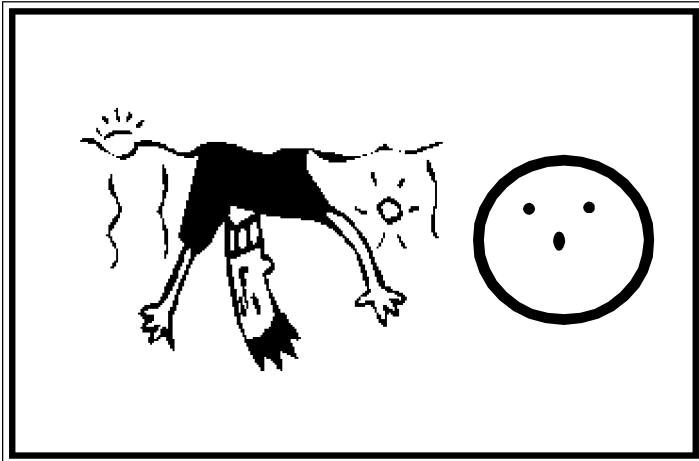




Happy or Sad?

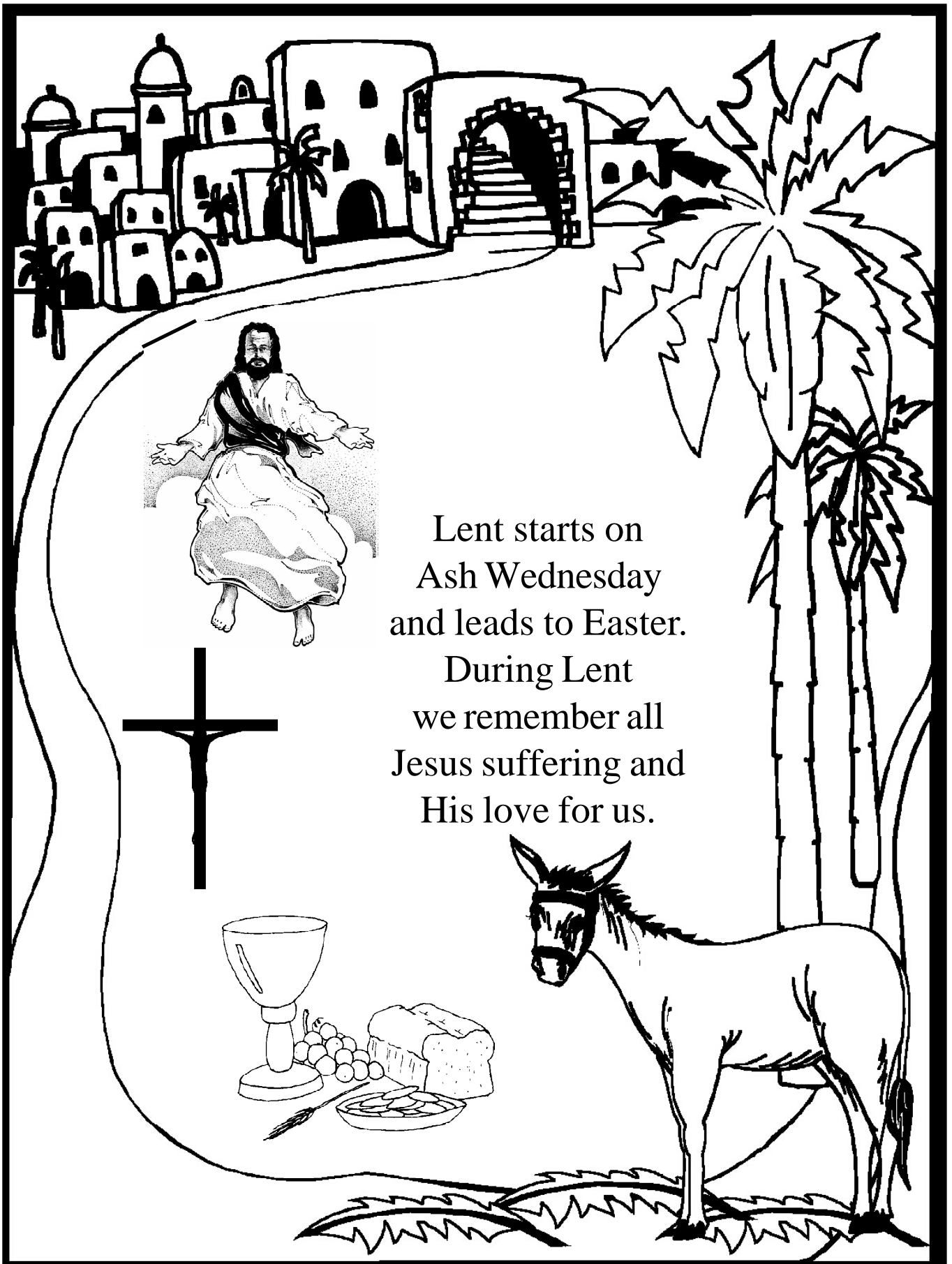


Abraham

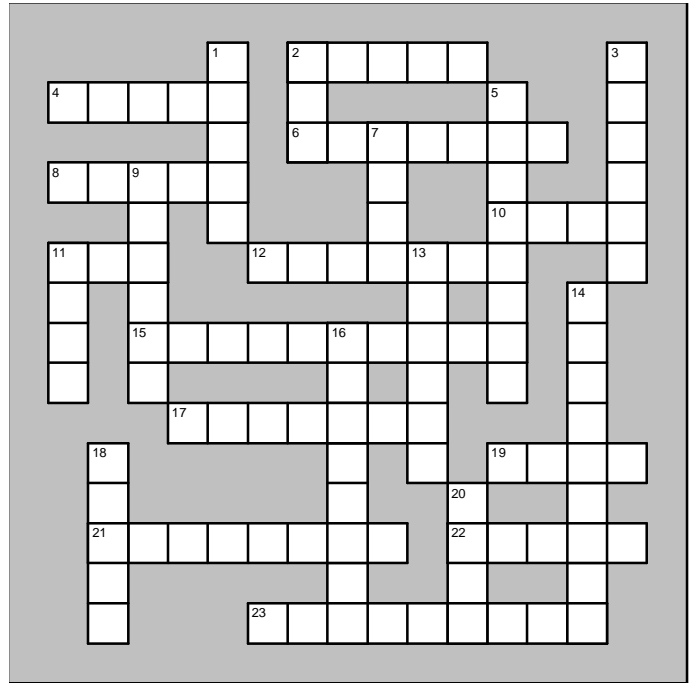

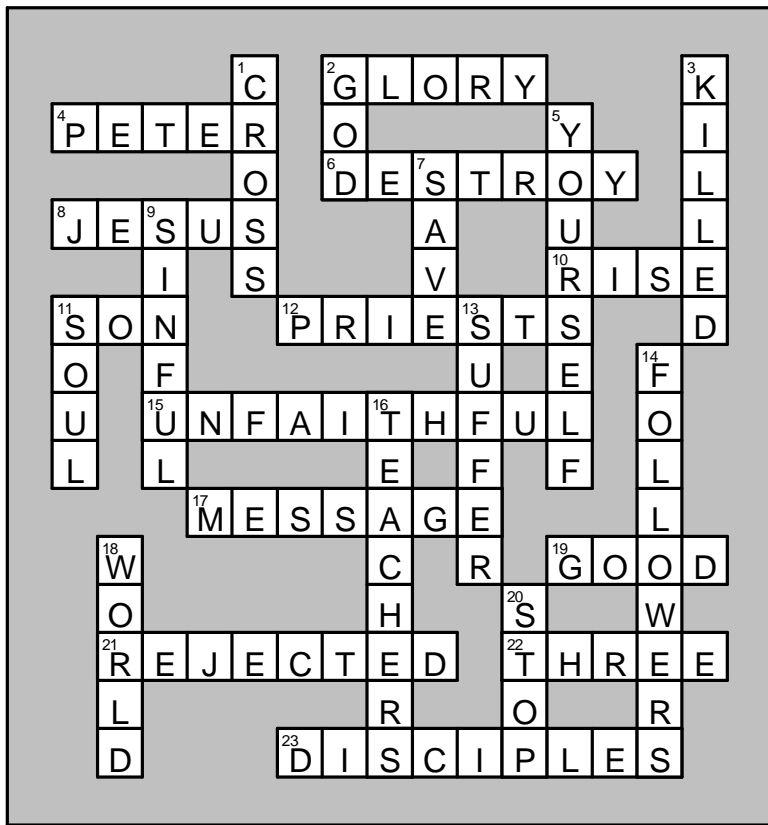
